The President opened the meeting at 8:35 pm, following conclusion of the AGM.

#### ATTENDANCE and APOLOGIES: As per the AGM.

The minutes for the 6<sup>th</sup> November 2024 General Meeting of Federation had been published in Feathered World and were displayed on the screen and paper copies distributed to delegates in attendance It was moved J. Walsh and seconded C. Gruntar that the minutes be adopted as a true record of the November General meeting – Carried

**Matters arising out of the minutes:** None other than matters that can be held over for Reports and General Business.

#### In-coming correspondence as follows:

- Affiliated clubs. Notification of office bearers and delegate
- Affiliated clubs requesting assistance with matters regarding insurance.
- Affiliated clubs, receipt of ring orders for 2025.
- Affiliated clubs, payments for ring orders from various affiliates.
- Confirmation of cover and renewal terms for the Public Liability cover for listed affiliates for 2025, together with the invoice.
- Receipt of renewal terms for the Marine insurance for the period from 31 December 2024 to 31 December 2025.

- Insurance Broker, CGU underwriter advised a new requirement has been released (an Event Risk Assessment) for where the event is being held, also advising estimated attendee numbers. It is required to be implemented as part of the next renewal for events who have more than 500 people attending, or the event goes over more than 1 day.
- Ashfield RSL Confirmation of the dates requested for the ANZAC Room for 2025 meetings.
- Manly Warringah Avicultural Society Inc. nominating Bob Barnes for future Guest of Honour consideration.
- Zebra Finch Society of Australia Inc. Re alteration to the Standard Finch show cage: Black electrical tape is allowed to be used on the door latch of Finch show cages to secure the door against accidentally coming open. The specifications are for black electrical tape, approx. 18mm wide and cut to approx.. 40mm long, to be used horizontally across the door latch to secure it.

- 1. Australian Animal Welfare Strategy (AAWS) DAFF website: <u>www.agriculture.gov.au/agriculture-land/animal/welfare/aaws</u>
- 2. The President stated there has been very little progress and concern for a number of representatives appear to have RSPCA attachment.
- 3. NSW NPWS Species List Advisory Committee (LSAC). The president advised there has been no information from NPWS other than to acknowledge responses to the code of practice that we all sent. The only other development are problems with their e record system as they are trying to update it. Overall, very disappointing to date from NPWS, especially when in 2017 NPWS spent \$2.5m with an external consultant Rob Oliver, who presented an excellent report. CCBFA Deputy representative Brian Read, commented that a number of licence holders were experiencing issues with up dating their electronic records and had been advised to maintain their records so they can update the NPWS have their system up and running.
- 4. Councils' draft animal Policies, Shellharbour and Uralla: The President advised that the ACA have addressed the issues, Keepers of more than 50 birds should be members of official Agricultural Societies' It should be noted that the keepers of some poultry may be members of Agricultural Societies, the keepers of avian birds would be members of Avicultural Societies.

#### **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

- 1. RAS Update RAS Greg Davie has advised entries closed 19<sup>th</sup> February, the show dates for the Cage Bird show at the 2025 Royal Easter Show will be Monday 14th and Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2025. Benching will be Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> from 6pm, and Monday 14<sup>th</sup> from 6am to 8am.Judging 14<sup>th</sup> April. Colin Isbister advised there were 471 entries from 42 exhibitors, the feature bird this year being the African Lovebird with 95 exhibits. Brian Read advised that the FSA and NSW Avicultural Society were providing the volunteers for maintaining the aviaries and would be in attendance for the duration of the show.
- 2. **Ring Orders 2025,** Supplementary orders will be ongoing during 2025, however delivery time frame and cost for transshipment will vary.Clubs requiring an order form to be completed, should contact the Secretary.
- 3. Show and Sale dates for 2025 Clubs are requested to email Matt McKenzie the dates for their 2025 shows, sales, and auctions, including phone number of the contact person and venue details. It is understood that confirmation of the venue may be in abeyance / pending, however we request the tentative / projected dates be advised. Email clubs@ccbfa.org.au
- 4. **INSURANCE**. Requirement for CCBFA and clubs to maintain proof of membership, by maintaining and membership register and individual membership forms.
- 5. **INSURANCE EVENT RISK ASSESSMENT.** As recorded in incoming correspondence, the CGU underwriter has advised that they have implemented a new requirement, (an EVENT RISK ASSESSMENT) for when events have more than 500 people attending, or the event goes over more than one day.
  - CGU have provided a template to assist if the club does not have a risk assessment template. This template lists a number of risks, which may or may not apply to the insured's events. Using the CGU template, you can delete or write N/A in the corresponding fields.
  - The intention of the risk assessment is to show that the affiliates are considering the risks and mitigating/preventing them. Assessing the risks will mean you will know how to respond, if/when an incident occurs.
  - Regarding the number of people attending events, this information is to understand the size and exposure of each which will better help understand the risk as a whole.
  - The insurance policy cover is not changing only the underwriter's requirement for the information

- We presently require notification of the event (name, dates, venue/ address, where known) to be received by the end of October for the following year events.
- On receipt of club's payment for the renewal of affiliation and insurance, a "General" insurance certificate will be issued (as we currently do) to enable the affiliates to initiate bookings.
- For all shows, sales, auctions, conventions and other events with more than the 500 attendees or are more than a one-day event an "Event Risk Assessment" must be submitted to the CCBFA secretary, for the event / venue (as soon as the venue name / address, dates are known). If using the same venue in subsequent years, you will only be required to advise the date and estimate number of people attending.
- After the affiliate has submitted an "Event Risk Assessment" for the event / venue, an amended insurance certificate will be issued, endorsing the details of the event. Only then will the event be insured.
- 6 **Guest of Honour Dinner:** Consideration to combining with the Border Fancy Canary Club of Australia Inc. 80<sup>th</sup> Annual Show anniversary luncheon, suggested venue Panorama House, Bulli Tops, Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> July, John Walker has made a tentative booking with the same menu last year. (Two course buffet, including beer, wine, soft drink, tea and coffee, cost \$70.00) Moved R. Robertson and seconded by C. Isbister that we stay with the same menu and accept the price \$70.00. – carried
- 7 The nominations received for Guest of Honour to be addressed by the GoH selection committee for the 2025 luncheon.
- **ACA**: The President expressed his appreciation for the involvement of the ACA at all levels of government and canvassed the suggestion of making a financial contribution. The consensus of the meeting was to leave any decision in abeyance. The Secretary suggested that we offer a page advert in Feathered World and again encourage affiliates to join the ACA, also to include provision for a donation to the ACA on our renewal invoice for affiliation and insurance. The President to speak to the ACA President about the advert.

The President thanked the delegates for attending, as there was no further business the meeting closed at 9:20 p.m.

#### Secretary's Report 2024- AGM 5th March 2025

Fellow delegates,

I express my thanks to all affiliate clubs' secretaries, treasurers and ring secretaries for their co-operation and communication throughout the year. It is encouraging to have most clubs making payments by EFT or DD. Your timely replies and attention to payments for ring orders and renewal of affiliation and insurance invoices together with notification of changes in office bearers greatly assists the recording of updates.

To those who I have had the opportunity to speak with, it is always enjoyable to catch up.

As I have previously mentioned to some, the Public Liability insurance renewal processes this year was challenging, with a new underwriter, coupled with changes in underwriting guidelines for group accounts, which has initiated additional reporting and accountability which will be addressed by all affiliates before the next renewal. This year we have insured 254 affiliated clubs after the closure of 3 clubs. (256 affiliates)

We continue to have an ongoing good personal relationship with our ring suppliers. Placing ring orders in 2024 for 57,000 rings and having to date placed orders of 46,000 for 2025, with supplementary orders to follow.

### COVERT BIRD SPIES!!

tracking device attached to its leg. A local fisherman in the Nile River spotted the suspicious bird, captured it, and handed it over to the police.


Which spying agency in the ME could have possibly thought of using such an innocent bird as a spy?

The device was later found to be a standard device used by French scientists for locating migratory birds. The stork was "cleared" of suspicion, but our story has a bitter end. Shortly after its release, the stork was recaptured and eaten.

In 2013, the Turkish police captured a small falcon with an Israeli tracking device on its leg. A scientific team at the University of Pirat classified the bird as an "Israeli spy" in their documents. The bird underwent a series of tests, including X-ray scans, which proved that no spy equipment had been implanted in its body.

However, the falcon appeared to have held a grudge against the staff due to the intrusive tests - a distinct "Jewish characteristic" according to some Turks.

If those stories sound ridiculous, and you would like to know about some actual brilliant win-win situation, here you go: the IDF is using wild antelopes as a natural weed wacker around bases as a measure for fire prevention.

## WHAT IS A FALLOW BUDGIE? [ALL MUTATIONS & VARIETIES]

A fallow budgie is a budgie which is a mutation that reduces the black **eumelanin** pigments in the eyes and the body. This reduction in eumelanin pigments causes red eyes and pastel tones, brown markings on the body feathers of the fallow budgies.

The level of reduction in eumelanin pigmentation, combined with other color mutations and variations, produces many different variations and mutations such as English, German, Scottish, Australian, Japanese, bronze, pale, dun, smokey and ashen, light green, dark green, olive green, gray-green, sky blue (light blue), cobalt (dark blue), mauve, violet, gray-blue.

In addition to that, some typical features are available and shared by many varieties.

# How to identify a fallow budgie?

A fallow budgie has a gene that removes black eumelanin from the eyes and the body.

To identify a fallow budgie, breeders should look at eye color and body color. The eyes and the body losses black colors on different levels.

A fallow budgie eye color must be closer to ruby-red color. Fallow gene removes black eumelanin and blood flow in the eyes be-



gins to give the bird's eye reddish colors in different levels.

A fallow budgie's body color can have different levels of reductions of black color. Different levels of black color reduction generate different varieties of fallow budgies such as bronze, dun, pale.

Fallow gene removes black eumelanin at different levels. Having or not having a white eyes ring is not an identification feature to be a fallow budgie. But, it is an identification feature in fallow budgie mutations, like German budgie (German budgies have white iris ring).

#### Here are common fallow budgie features:

- 1. Orange beak
- 2. Red or plum eye colors
- 3. Eyes with or without a white iris
- 4. Pinkish gray feet
- 5. Pinkish gray legs
- 6. Brownish or light blue cere colors in females
- 7. Fleshy pink or purple cere colors in males
- 8. Gray and violet cheek patches
- 9. Markings are located on cheeks, back of head, neck and wings
- 10.Blueish or brownish gray with a brown quill.

NOTE: Fallow budgies do not have the **ino** gene, so colors can be seen, albeit at the lowest level. (Ino gene removes all color pigments and creates albino and <u>lutino budgies</u>.)



### ANOTHER RARE BIRD SIGHT IN AUSSIE BACKYARD STUNS

The incredible black kookaburra appears to have melanism which changes it's usually white or grey feathers to a shade of black.

It's not every day you come across a 'one in a billion' find sitting in your backyard. But that was the reality for one woman who recently spotted a rare black kookaburra – with the close encounter sparking envy among Aussies.



"Is this an extremely dirty blue-winged kookaburra or is there something else going on?" she questioned on social media alongside pictures of the "stunning" and "amazing" native bird this week. And she wasn't alone in questioning why the usually white or grey feathers appeared to be a deep shade of black.

Australian bird expert Britt, known online as, well, 'Britt the Bird Expert', agreed it's "pretty rare" when speaking to Yahoo News Australia about the images shared online. The bird "looks to be melanistic", she said.

"Melanism is when excess melanin pigment is produced in an animal's fur, feathers or scales," she explained. "Melanism is usually something they are born with and it is pretty rare."

She described it as a "random genetic fluke" with famous Aussie vet Dr Chris Brown previously suggesting it's possibly a "one in a billion" phenomenon. "Only a handful of black kookaburras ... have ever been reported in the world," he previously shared after a **Perth** sighting in 2018.


### WHAT IS MELANISM AND LEUCISTISM IN BIRDS?

Explaining melanism further, Britt said it's been documented in many bird species. It's common in ducks, game birds, and many birds of prey, but in rare cases, penguins, flamingos, egrets, and many small garden birds too.

It's also responsible for creating black leopards and black foxes. "The disruption of normal placement of the pigment melanin can make a melanistic animal, partially or entirely black, black and white, reddish, or oddly patterned," she explained.

While melanistic animals have an excess of pigment, the opposite is said of leucistic beings which lack pigment. Leucistism has been documented in several birds living in urban Aussie areas, particularly among magpies — but sometimes kookaburras as well. Amazingly, a leucistic platypus and several kangaroos have also been reported in the past.

Different to albinism, leucistic animals have reduced pigmentation that can occur due to either environmental or genetic factors, making them white.

#### CRITICALLY ENDANGERED ORANGE-BELLIED PARROTS RETURN TO TASMANIA: 90 SPOTTED

Around 90 critically endangered orange-bellied parrots have arrived in Tasmania for the summer, providing a glimmer of hope for the species' survival.

Volunteers with the Orange-bellied Parrot Tasmanian Program have confirmed the arrival of two more parrots to Melaleuca in recent days, both of which were wild-born last season from nest boxes erected on poles.

Of the 90 parrots currently in the South-west National Park, 62 are wild-born and 28 are captive-bred and 37 are females and 53 are males.

With the orange-bellied parrot being one of Australia's most threatened bird species the team is now eagerly awaiting the results of an annual census, which is due shortly.

"We are into the final days before our census date and we are all very excited to see what the 2024/25 number will be," the team said.

May 2016 figures put the population at about 50 remaining in the wild and a captive breeding population of around 320.


# FOSSIL FINDS REVEAL AUSTRALIA ONCE HOME TO ENORMOUS 'FLYING TURKEYS'

As tall as a grey kangaroo but capable of flight, Australia's early explorers would surely have wigged out had they encountered the country's original giant turkeys.

Black swans. Huge hopping 'mice'. Would Australia's early explorers have totally flipped out had they encountered our giant flying turkeys?

Though they had long since gone the way of rhinoceros-sized wombats (Diprotodon) and drop-bears (Thylacoleo carnifex), it turns out ancient Australia was once inhabited by a variety of giant birds.

And we've only just discovered they existed.



"More than half of Australia's megapodes went extinct during the Pleistocene, and we didn't even realise it until now," says Flinders PhD candidate and researcher Elen Shute.

Their discovery is published in a recent edition of the science journal *Royal Society Open Science*.

In the case of Progura gallinacea, a "tall turkey" it was as tall as a grey kangaroo. And it flew.

The oversized bush turkey stands tall among a list of five extinct megapode (incubator) birds discovered by palaeontologists at Flinders University.

The researchers carefully compared a scattering of fossils gathered from Queensland, New South Wales, South Australia and Western Australia. The sorting process revealed the five different varieties, ranging in weight from 3kg to 8kg. By comparison modern Malleefowl top out at 2kg.

"Given several of the largest birds to have lived in Australia in recent times have escaped detection in the fossil record until now, our research shows how little we know of Australia's immediate prehuman avifauna," says Associate Professor Trevor Worthy. "Probably many smaller extinct species also await discovery by palaeontologists,"

Alongside the 'tall turkeys' fluttered a variety of 'nuggety chickens' which have had to be given a new category of their own, genus Latagallina.

The Flinders University researchers say the giant bids do not appear to have built nesting mounds as their modern cousins do. They didn't have the necessary specialised claws or large feet. Instead, they probably buried their eggs in warm sand in the same way some Indonesian megapode varieties still do today.

And while big and bulky, the Flinders study says all five species could likely fly — and may have roosted in trees.

The first giant bird fossils were found in Queensland in the 1880s, and another batch in South Australia's Naracoorte Caves in the 1970s.

These painted a rough outline of one or two species inhabiting Pleistocene Australia — which probably shrank to become modern Malleefowl. But, when put alongside more recent fossil studies, that argument no longer holds up.

Evidence for two of the new species come from the Thylacoleo Caves beneath the Nullarbor Plane. The caves, found 15 years ago, are proving a treasure trove of fossils for Australia's megafauna.

"So far the Thylacoleo Caves have yielded seven new species of kangaroo, a frog, two giant ground-cuckoos, and now two new megapodes," says **Professor Gavin Prideaux**. "The closer we look, the more we keep finding."

### **BE BIRD FLU AWARE!**

Bird flu is a viral disease of birds and is found across the globe. It mainly affects birds, but can also affect other animals, and, on rare occasions, humans.

H5 bird flu, specifically high pathogenicity avian influenza H5N1 clade 2.3.4.4b is a serious and highly contagious strain that has moved quickly around the world. Australia is currently the only continent free from this strain of H5 bird flu.

Wild, farmed and pet birds can catch bird flu. Overseas, other animals have become infected by this strain of H5 bird flu. These were mainly marine mammals and bird-eating scavengers but cases have been detected in dairy cattle, cats, goats, alpacas, pigs and horses.

If Australia experiences an outbreak of H5 bird flu, there will be a rapid and coordinated national response led by the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF), with state and territory governments leading response activities within their borders.

#### Steps to protect your birds

People with aviary birds, pet birds or back yard poultry should take the following eight steps to protect their birds.

- 1. Keep your equipment and poultry yard or aviary clean.
- 2. Avoid contact between your birds and wild birds.
- 3. Don't let feed and water become contaminated by faeces or other animal waste.
- 4. Practice good hygiene when handling birds including at bird shows.
- 5. Limit visitors' access to your birds.
- 6. Quarantine new birds.
- 7. Know the signs of disease.
- 8. Immediately report any sick or dead birds.

If you see sick or dead birds, talk to your local vet or call the **Emergency Animal Disease Hotline** on **1800 675 888**. This will put you in touch with your state or territory agriculture department. Bird flu is a notifiable animal diseases and you must report a suspected outbreak.


